

Club Rules

The bartender has the authority to refuse service to any member or guest.

Bartender has the authority to ask any member or guest to leave the club.

Only the bartender, officers, and board of directors shall open the front door to let people in.

All non-related guests must be signed in at the serving area upon club entry.

All guests must leave with sponsor.

Members are responsible for damage to club property by their guests.

Any perspective member must sign a waiting list. New members will be taken in order as per the list.

Non-Members signed in will be allowed three visits before having to sign the waiting list.

All drinks other than bar seats must be served from the serving area.

No smoking in the club during youth events.

Excessive profanity will not be tolerated.

Park at your own risk. Club is not responsible for damaged or stolen items.

Any firearms won at the club will be transferred to the winner at the clubs expense before leaving the property.

Range Hours are from 9:00 AM to dusk.

Members and guests must fill out the range books with all pertinent information and times.

The upper range will be closed for all trap seasons and shoots.

The upper range will be closed for all pavilion rentals.

Upper and lower ranges will be closed for all hunting seasons. They are open on Sunday during hunting seasons.

The ranges will be open after the regular muzzle-loading season in the pa-hunting schedule.

Emergency shooting during hunting seasons for scope replacements or dropped weapons will be on the upper range only.

No semi or full automatic weapons allowed on the upper range.

No shooting the frames on ranges. Targets must be place in the center section of the Yard markers.

All targets, shells and casings need to be cleaned up and thrown away after shooting.

No dumping on the club property.

Woodcutting for members only. The board will give out permission.

No cutting standing wood on club property for personal use.

ATV and all recreational riding on club property for members only.
